- 1. Create a list of key vocabulary words from the text. These words should be words that you are unfamiliar with and words that address the conflicts, themes, and plot development.
- 2. Identify plot structure and events in the novel.
- 3. Identify characters and trace their development throughout the text, and their motivations.
- 4. Analyze and connect the different conflicts within the text.
- 5. Think about how the setting affects the events and the development of the plot.
- 6. Connect how the narrator's point of view affects the telling of the story.
- 7. Analyze the various themes throughout the text.
- 8. Explain the purpose of the text. (Why you think the author wrote this text?)

Assessment:

Students will be assessed through various class activities and discussions. The students need to be prepared to discuss the text during the first cycle of class.
